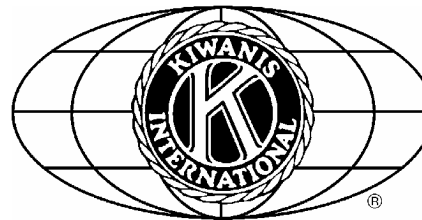
## THE MOTTO

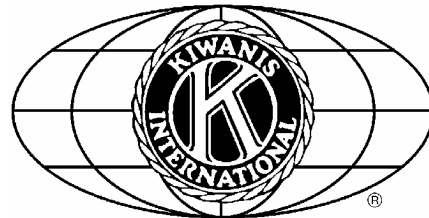


## Responsibility of Membership

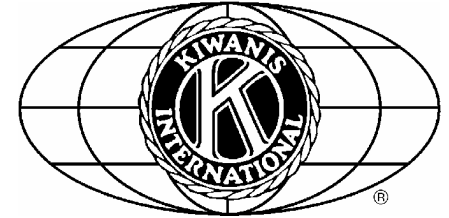
## Objects of Kiwanis
